Report of the drafting group

DRAFT TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR THE CORRESPONDENCE GROUP ON DEVELOPMENT OF OPTIONS TO IMPROVE EFFECT OF THE 1969 TM CONVENTION ON SHIP DESIGN AND SAFETY

The correspondence group should, taking into account the previous discussions of the issue within the framework of the Sub-Committee:

- consider further and finalize the information provided in annex 2 to document SLF 52/5/2 (Report of the correspondence group) with respect to improving the effect of the 1969 Convention on the design of ships and in particular with reference to the effect on safety;
- .2 examine, in relation to the options listed in annex 2 to document SLF 52/5/2:
 - .1 improvement of crew accommodation (other than training berths); and
 - .2 the tonnage measurement of ships carrying deck cargoes and, in particular, of containerships;
- .3 identify and investigate the benefits and disadvantages of the options listed in annex 2 to document SLF 52/5/2; and
- .4 submit a report to SLF 53.
