<p><b><u>Tank Barge PIC (DL) or (LG) Formerly Tankerman PIC Barge (DL or (LG) within 5 years:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 15 days service (shore or vessel based) on tank vessels certified to carry DL or LG as appropriate; <b>OR</b></li> <li>• 45 days closely related service directly involved with tank barges: <b>OR</b></li> <li>• 15 days <u>service only</u> on OSVs in which the COI <u>requires</u> a Tank PIC or a licensed officer authorized to conduct or supervise transfers, <b>AND</b></li> <li>• Two transfers to include commencement of loading and completion of discharge.</li> </ul> <p><b>NOTE:</b> Upon renewal of Tank Barge PIC, add Tank Vessel Assistant with same cargo restriction (DL or LG), no exam. Issue Tank Vessel Assistant whether it is requested on the application or not.</p>			
<p><b><u>Tank Vessel Assistant (DL) or (LG) Formerly Tankerman Assistant (DL) or (LG) within 5 years:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 23 days deck service on tank ship or self-propelled tank vessels certified to carry DL or LG as appropriate, <b>OR</b></li> <li>• Successful completion of a USCG exam or approved course in lieu of exam.</li> </ul>			
<p><b><u>Tank Vessel Engineer (DL or (LG) Formerly Tankerman Engineer (DL) or (LG) within 5 years:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 23 days as rating, deck or engineer officer on tank ships or self-propelled tank vessel certified to carry DL or LG as appropriate.</li> </ul>			
<p><b>Notes:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Documentation of cargo transfers must include the information specified in 46 CFR 13.127(a).</li> <li>2. Transfers on OSVs when the COI <u>requires</u> a Tank PIC or a licensed officer authorized to conduct or supervise transfers are acceptable for either Tank Vessel PIC or Tank Barge PIC.</li> <li>3. Transfers or service may be accepted on approved ATBs.</li> </ol>
