New Public Portal Website for Civil Penalty Enforcement Cases

The U.S. Coast Guard (USCG) announces the launch of a new Public Portal website for individuals and companies that are the party, or counsel for the party, in a civil penalty action initiated by the USCG in accordance with 33 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Subpart 1.07. This new capability has been added to the USCG's Marine Information for Safety and Law Enforcement (MISLE) data system as part of the Service's MISLE Enforcement and Adjudication Modernization (MEAM) project. The website is found at:

Once registered, users have the following options:

- View the civil penalty case details.
- Respond to a Preliminary Inquiry (Recreational or Commercial) Letter from the Violations Case Coordination Center (VCCC).
- Respond (accept or decline) to a Letter of Warning.
- Respond (accept or decline) to a Notice of Violation in accordance with <u>33 CFR 1.07-11</u>.
- Take the following actions in a case before a USCG Hearing Officer:
 - o Submit evidence in lieu of a hearing,
 - o Pay the proposed penalty,
 - o Request a payment plan,
 - o Request an extension, or
 - o Request a hearing.
