CERTIFICATE OF DOCUMENTATION APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL

Renewal Durations and Fees:

- **Recreational** (endorsed with Recreation only) Certificate of Documentation (COD) holders may renew CODs for one to five years at a cost of \$26.00 per year.
- **Commercial** vessel owners may renew CODs for one year at a cost of \$26.00.
- Fees are non-refundable per 46 CFR 67.500(d).

CODs renewed **more than 60 days prior to expiration** will be issued with a new issue/expiration date, shortening the validity period of your current document. CODs renewed 60 days or less from expiration will maintain the same expiration month.

Renewal requests received **up to 30 days after the expiration date** of the COD will be considered late and will require payment of a \$5 late fee in addition to any other application fees.

Renewal requests received **31 days after the expiration date** of the COD will result in the COD being expired and will require reinstatement, which can be processed in eStorefront.

When renewing **vessel fleets**, a list of vessels must be submitted at the same time as the payment.
