Captain Sean Brady serves as the Chief, Office of Operating and Environmental Standards at Coast Guard Headquarters in Washington, D.C. In this position, he leads the development of operational safety and environmental protection standards for the nation's marine transportation system, commercial shipping, and offshore oil and gas activity.

His previous assignments include serving as Executive Officer of the Coast Guard Marine Safety Center, Washington DC; Commanding Officer of Sector Field Office Grand Haven Michigan, Coast Guard City USA; Executive Officer at Marine Safety Unit Chicago, Willowbrook, Illinois; as the Small Vessel Branch Chief and Salvage Engineering Response Team member at the Marine Safety Center, Washington DC; as a Marine Inspector

at Activities New York, Staten Island, New York; and an Engineering Officer in Training, Engineer of the Watch, and Deck Watch Officer aboard the USCGC SPENCER (WMEC 905), Boston, Massachusetts.

Captain Brady graduated from the United States Coast Guard Academy in 1996 with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Naval Architecture and Marine Engineering, and earned a Masters of Engineering in the same from the University of Michigan in 2004.

His personal awards include four Coast Guard Commendation Medals, the DOT 9-11 Medal, three Achievement Medals, two Commandant's Letters of Commendation, and various service, team, and unit awards.
