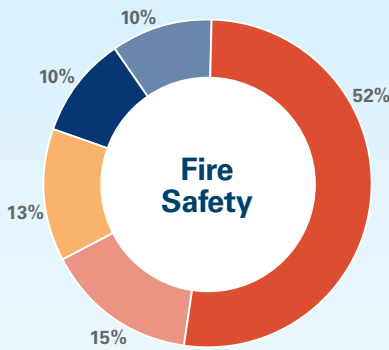


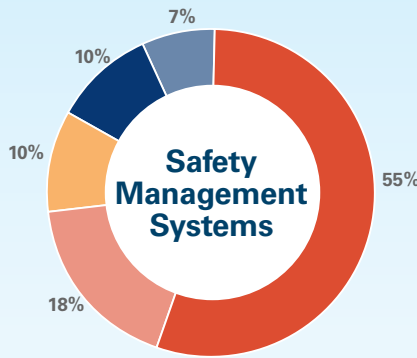
# U.S. Coast Guard PSC Detainable Deficiencies Overview 2023

Deficiencies related to Fire Safety, Safety Management Systems, and Life Saving Systems were the leading deficiency categories that led to ships being detained by the U.S. Coast Guard in 2023. The below graphs are excerpts taken from the Coast Guard’s 2023 PSC Annual Report showing the top five deficiencies in each category.



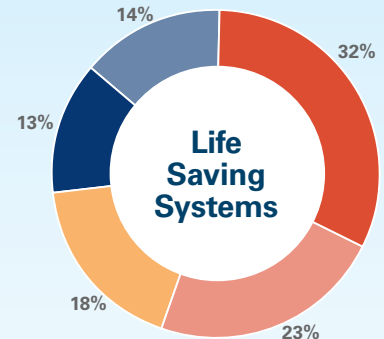
**61 Deficiencies**

- Oil Accumulation in Engine Room
- Fire Detection and Alarm Systems
- Operation of Fire Protection Systems
- Fire Fighting Equipment and Appliances
- Remote Means of Control



**72 Deficiencies**

- Maintenance of Ship & Equipment
- Shipboard Operations
- Resources and Personnel
- Other (ISM)
- Reports of Non-conformities



**22 Deficiencies**

- Rescue Boats
- Lifeboats
- Stowage and Provision of Liferafts
- Operational Readiness of Lifesaving Appliances
- Stowage and Provision of Lifeboats
