Description

The company and the ship shall comply with the requirements of the international Safety Management Code. In meeting these requirements, the company should ensure that appropriate corrective action is taken. PSCO observed that the vessel and company did not provide timely corrective action for deficiencies listed below. Due to the failure of implementing the Safety Management System (SMS), and external audit of the SMS shall be carried out.

**10114 - Voyage data recorder  
(VDR)/Simplified Voyage data  
recorder(S-VDR)**

The administration shall be satisfied that adequate arrangements are in place to ensure that the performance of the equipment [VDR] required by this chapter [Ch. V. Regulation 20] is maintained. PSCO observed the failure of the Voyage Data Recorder due to multiple VDR error codes. The errors indicate that the unit is rendered incapable of storing data, the display unit was disconnected, and Radar input failure, making the unit substantially unable to comply with the basic functions of its operation. The inability to meet the basic functions of operation constitutes a failure of the VDR.
