01102 - Cargo Ship Safety When a nominated surveyor or recognized organization **Construction (including exemption)** determines that the condition of the ship or its equipment does not correspond substantially with the particulars of the certificate... such surveyor or organization shall immediately ensure that corrective action is taken and shall in due course notify the Administration. PSCO observed that the Interim Cargo Ship Safety Construction Certificate did not have the most recient drvdock date listed. This deficiency is considered RO Related. 01107 - Safety Management The company and ship shall comply with the Certificate (SMC/ ISM) requirements of the International Safety Management Code. For the purpose of this regulation, the requirements of the Code shall be treated as mandatory. An Interim Safety Management Certificate should be issued for a period not exceeding six months by the Administration or an organization recognized by the Administration. PSCO observed Interim Safety

Management Certificate was issued 14 FEB 2024 till 13 FEB 2025 (12 months) and subsequent current Interim Safety Management Certificate was issued for six months.

This deficiency is considered RO Related.
