Description

All ships, irrespective of size, shall have: nautical charts and nautical publications to plan and display the ship's route for the Intended voyage and to plot and monitor positions throughout the voyage. An electronic chart display and information system (ECDIS) is also accepted as meeting the chart carriage requirements of this subparagraph. Ships to which paragraph 2.10 applies shall comply with the carriage requirements for ECDIS detailed therein: .5 back-up arrangements to meet the functional requirements of subparagraph .4. if this function is partly or fully fulfilled by electronic means. PSCO's observed the vessel having one method of electronic charting which is not up to date, does not meet the requirements set forth in IMO Res. A.817(19) and does not have a means for updating. Additionally the vessel has no secondary means of navigation. The Caribbean Cargo Record of Equipment states the vessel has no ECDIS or method of electronic charting.
