# 17th District Coordinator Report

- **CFV losses FY19 – 6**
- **CFV fatalities FY19 - 2**
- **CFV injuries FY19 - 35**
- **CFV population within District (State/Documented) - 8893**
- **Dockside Exams completed (within District FY19) - 1601**
- **Outreach initiatives:**
  - Conducted outreach visits to 30+ remote communities in Alaska conducting CFVS exams
  - Safety training collaboration with Alaska Department of Fish and Game
- **District priorities:**
  - Continue robust dockside examination outreach program
  - Maximize interactions with industry (trade shows, association meetings, council meetings etc)
  - Maintain pace with changing fishing operations/trends in D17 (less ice, moving north, proximity to CG assets/rescue)
  - An aging fleet (ACSA vessels, fish tenders)
  - Small vessel (skiff) operations/casualties
  - Stability for smaller vessels and updating stability on larger vessels to allow for modifications, weight creep etc...
  - Ensuring a culture of safety in the D17 fishing fleet
- **District sponsored fishing industry expos, forums, meetings:**
  - Co-sponsoring public meeting in November for fish tender load line issue
  - Attendance at Bristol Bay Fish Expo, ComFish Kodiak Trade Show and Pacific Marine Expo
