**Description:** Navios Terminal has a dedicated pathway from the guard post to the dock for crewmembers and vendors.

**Discussion:** Restricting facility access for the ships crewmembers serves as security and safety precaution. The dedicated pathway allows crewmembers to transit the facility without getting entering the facility. The area is monitored by CCTV and the only exit is the guard post.

**Potential Down-side:** None.

**Conclusion:** Navios Terminal has identified a way to maintain access control in the spirit of the ISPS Code. The pathway permits crewmembers to come and go as needed while maintaining security on the facility.

**Cost:** The cost for this best practice is low to medium. Cost will depend on the type of pathway and fencing for the distance from the entrance to the dock.
