Description: Brunei Liquefied Natural Gas posts Security News Flashes in conspicuous locations at the entry to the facility. The flashes are posted on bulletin boards in such a way that they are readily viewed by all persons entering the facility.

Discussion: All persons accessing the facility must go through this access point. Visitors are checked and given temporary ID cards to the facility. After obtaining their ID cards, they are required to wait in line for a personal search before entering. The security flashes are posted in a way that visitors and employees are given the opportunity to scan them and read further if necessary before going through the turnstiles.

Potential Down-side: A potential downside is to ensure that they are changed frequently with new items, so that employees won't tend to overlook them. Also, they should be made more conspicuous and require that they be read before accessing facility.

Conclusion: This approach is a good means of providing the latest security information for the facility.

Cost: The cost is minimal with the investment in the bulletin board and ensuring that alerts are posted in a timely and consistent way.
