DRAFT RECOMMENDATION ON DEFINITIONS
OF TERMS

Note by the Secretariat

In accordance with the decision taken by the Committee that a Recommendation of the Conference on the uniform interpretation of definition of terms should be drawn up, the following draft text of such a Recommendation has been prepared, which could be used as a basis for consideration by the Committee:.

"The Conference, recognizing that the definitions of certain terms used in the International Convention on Tonnage Measurement of Ships, 1969, such as length and passenger, are identical to those contained in other conventions of which the Organization is depositary, recommends that Contracting Governments should take steps to ensure that identical definitions of terms used in such conventions should be interpreted in a uniform and consistent manner."
