



National Merchant Mariner Medical Advisory Committee Intersessional Meeting of the Subcommittee on Recommendations for Seafarer Training Requirements in Mental Health and Women’s Health

The Office of Merchant Mariner Credentialing is hosting an intersessional meeting of the National Merchant Mariner Medical Advisory Committee (NMEDMAC) subcommittee on [Task Statement 24-03](#): Recommendations for Seafarer Training Requirements on Mental Health and Women’s Health. The subcommittee will meet virtually through Microsoft Teams on August 14, 2024, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (EDT).

NMEDMAC advises, consult with, and makes recommendations to the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security through the Commandant of the United States Coast Guard on matters relating to: (1) medical certification determinations for the issuance of licenses, certification of registry, and merchant mariners’ documents with respect to merchant mariners; (2) medical standards and guidelines for the physical qualifications of operators of commercial vessels; (3) medical examiner education; and (4) medical research.
