## New Application Status and Credential Verification Web-based Tools Now Available

The National Maritime Center (NMC) is pleased to announce the launch of two new self-service tools, available via the <a href="MMC website">NMC website</a>, are designed to assist mariners and industry stakeholders with obtaining Mariner Credential Application Status and Mariner Credential Verification.

- <u>Mariner Credential Application Status</u>: This tool allows users to receive application status updates via e-mail. To use this service, users must provide **Mariner's Last Name**,
   <u>Mariner's Reference Number</u>, and a valid e-mail address where results will be sent.
   <u>Note:</u> Application status data is updated Monday through Friday by 8:00 a.m. EST.
- <u>Mariner Credential Verification</u>: This tool provides credential verification results, via
  e-mail, for merchant mariner credentials and medical certificates. To use this service, users
  must provide **Mariner's Last Name**, **Mariner's Reference Number**, and a **valid**e-mail address where results will be sent. Once a submission is complete, users may click
  the **Submit another response** link to perform additional verifications.

Note: Credential verification data is updated Monday through Friday by 8:00 a.m. EST.
