360 days of service as officer in charge of a navigational watch on Ocean/NC or Great Lakes self-propelled vessels while holding an endorsement as 3 rd Mate, OR		
360 days of service while holding an endorsement as 3 rd Mate, OF WHICH 1. 180 days of service as officer in charge of a navigational watch on Ocean/NC steam or motor vessels, AND 2. Service as AB, Boatswain, or Quartermaster while holding an AB endorsement accepted on a 2 for 1 basis for a maximum of 180 days, OR	11.406	
A Master of GL &/or Inland of AGT, may obtain this endorsement by completing the prescribed examination.	11.406	
NOTE: Service towards an Oceans, or NC will be credited as follows: 1. Service on GL will be credited day for day. 2.
