<u>Tankerman PIC (DL) or (LG) within 5 years:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 23 days as rating, deck or engineer officer on tank ships or self-propelled tank vessel certified to carry DL or LG as appropriate, AND Two transfers to include commencement of loading and completion of discharge. 		
<u>Tankerman PIC Barge (DL or (LG) within 5 years:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 15 days service (shore or vessel based) on tank vessels certified to carry DL or LG as appropriate; OR 45 days closely related service directly involved with tank barges; OR 15 days <u>service only</u> on OSV's in which the COI <u>requires</u> a Tankerman PIC or a licensed officer authorized to conduct or supervise transfers, AND Two transfers to include commencement of loading and completion of discharge. 		

Tankerman Assistant (DL) or (LG) within 5 years: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 23 days deck service on tank ship or self-propelled tank vessels certified to carry DL or LG as appropriate, OR • Successful completion of a USCG exam or approved course in lieu of exam. 		
Tankerman Engineer (DL) or (LG) within 5 years: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 23 days as rating, deck or engineer officer on tank ships or self-propelled tank vessel certified to carry DL or LG as appropriate. 		
Notes: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Documentation of cargo transfers must include the information specified in 46 CFR 13.127(a). 2. Transfers on OSV's when the COI <u>requires</u> a Tankerman PIC or a licensed officer authorized to conduct or supervise transfers are acceptable for either Tankerman PIC or Tankerman PIC Barge. 3. Transfers or service may be accepted on approved ATB's.
