This includes the holders of C/M, 2 <sup>nd</sup> Mate, 3 <sup>rd</sup> Mate, Mate LT 1,600 GRT, Mate LT 500 GRT, C/M OSV, Mate OSV and Mate T/V.  ➤ Raise of Grade \$100 evaluation fee and \$45 issuance fee still required. ➤ Master 100 GRT will not be issued for oceans, only NC. ➤ Trade restrictions of OSV and T/V will not be endorsed.	46 CFR 15.901 PL 03-21

720 days of service in the deck department on Ocean, Near Coastal or Great Lakes waters, <b>OF WHICH</b> , service on inland waters may substitute for up to 360 days of the total required service.	11.428

<b>50 GRT</b> – 180 days (25%) of service on vessels of 26 GRT or above, <b>OR</b> , 360 days (50%) of service on vessels of 17 GRT or above.	11.422
