1. If holding Mate 25 GRT (service on deck, any position): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 45 days additional service on vessels of 0 - 25 GRT to increase to 50GRT. 		
2. If holding Mate 50 GRT (service on deck, any position): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 45 days additional service on vessels of 0 - 50 GRT to increase to 100GRT. 	11.422	
3. If holding Mate 100 GRT (service on deck, any position): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 45 days additional service on vessels of 0 - 100 GRT to increase to 200 GRT. 	11.422	
A tonnage limitation for master may be raised as follows:	11.422	
1. If holding Master 25 GRT (service on deck, any position): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 90 days additional service on vessels of 0 - 25 GRT to increase to 50 GRT. 		
2. If holding Master 50 GRT (service on deck, any position): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 90 days additional service on vessels of 0 - 50 GRT to increase to 100GRT. 	11.422
