RENEWAL OF ADVANCED FIREFIGHTING		
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Every 5 years, 360 days qualifying service in any capacity aboard a vessel that is required to hold regular fire and emergency drills; AND 2. Additional shore-side assessments must also be demonstrated by successful completion of a Coast Guard approved Advanced Fire Fighting Revalidation course completed within the previous 5-years. Completion of a Coast Guard approved Advanced Fire Fighting Refresher course also meets this requirement. For mariners that do not meet the sea time requirement: 3. Provide evidence of completing approved or accepted Advanced Fire Fighting course; OR 4. Provide evidence of completing an approved or accepted Advanced Fire Fighting refresher course that includes assessment of all competencies <p>FYI- Assessments <u>not satisfied</u> with sea service</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Control Firefighting Operations aboard ships, and 2. Organize and train fire parties, 3. Inspect and Service Fire-detection and extinguishing systems and equipment, 4.
