Advanced Oil Tanker Cargo Operations Limited to Non-Self-Propelled Vessels	46 CFR	
1. Qualify for a National Tankerman PIC Barge (DL); and, 2. Provide a Record of Transfers signed by the <i>master or chief mate</i> on the <u>OIL TANKER/BARGE</u> . NOTE: If the national transfer record is signed by someone other than the master or chief mate, a letter signed by the master or chief mate on the <u>OIL TANKER/BARGE</u> is also required indicating that the applicant is fully capable of supervising transfers of DL.	13.603 NVIC 22-14	
Advanced Oil Tanker Cargo Operations Limited to Maintenance and Repair of Cargo Equipment	46 CFR	
1. Qualify for a National Tankerman Engineer (DL); and, 2. Provide a service letter or separate letter that includes a statement signed by the <i>master or chief engineer</i> on the <u>OIL TANKER</u> that indicates the applicant is fully capable of supervising transfers of DL.	13.603 NVIC 22-14	
Cross-Over	46 CFR	
A mariner holding an endorsement in Advanced Chemical Tanker Cargo Operations or Advanced Liquefied Gas Tanker Cargo Operations may obtain an endorsement for Advanced Oil Tanker Cargo Operations by completing, in a supernumery capacity, an approved training program onboard OIL TANKERS (the program must be at least 1 month and include at least 3 loadings and 3 discharges).	13.603

Basic Training - Although not required to have current BT to qualify for the endorsement, in order to serve on a seagoing tank vessel of 500 GT or more, mariners must have currently valid BT. BT will not be endorsed unless qualified.	13.601 15.1105
