The program must be at least 1 month and include at least 3 loadings and 3 discharges.</p>	<p align="center">13.605</p>

<p>Basic Training - Although not required to have current BT to qualify for the endorsement, in order to serve on a seagoing tank vessel of 500 GT or more, mariners must have currently valid BT. Do not endorse BT unless qualified.</p>	<p align="center">13.601 15.1105</p>
