<b>50 GRT</b> – 45 days (25%) of service on vessels 26 GRT or above <b>OR</b> 90 days (50%) of service on vessels 17 GRT or above		
<b>25 GRT</b> – 136 days (75%) or more for endorsement on vessels 5 GRT or less <b>OR, 45 days (25%) or more on vessels 6-25 GRT, OR</b> 90 days (50%) or more on vessels 1-16 GRT <b>(If mariner does not meet the tonnage calculation for 50 GRT or more he or she is eligible for 25 GRT)</b>
