| 1. Qualify for a national endorsement as Tank Barge PIC LG or hold Tankerman PIC Barge (LG); and, 2. Provide a Record of Transfers signed by the <i>master or chief mate</i> on the <u>LIQUEFIED GAS TANKER/BARGE</u> . 3. See National Tankerman MMS, those issued Tank Barge PIC or holding Tankerman PIC Barge, will also be issued Tankerman Assistant, IF STCW is held or issued for non-self-propelled vessels, issue STCW Basic Liquefied Gas Tanker Operations, DO NOT include the non-self-propelled limitation. Issue Tankerman Assistant whether it is requested on the application or not. | Cross-Over | 46 CFR | | |
| A mariner who holds an endorsement in Advanced Oil Tanker Cargo Operations or Advanced Chemical Tanker Cargo Operations may obtain an endorsement for Advanced Liquefied Gas Tanker Cargo Operations by completing, in a supernumerary capacity, an approved training program onboard liquefied gas tankers. The program must be at least 1 month and include at least 3 loadings and 3 discharges. | 13.607 | PQEB | |

| Basic Training - Although not required to have current BT to qualify for the endorsement, in order to serve on a seagoing tank vessel of 500 GT or more, mariners must have currently valid BT. Do not endorse BT unless qualified. | 13.601 15.1105 | | |
