Mariners currently holding STCW officer endorsement limited to UFIV and only a national officer endorsement for UFIV may continue to renew as long as Basic Training renewal requirements have been met. The UFIV will continue to be endorsed as a limitation to the Master and the Basic Training will be listed as a separate capacity.

In order to remove the UFIV limitation, mariner must meet full STCW requirements as applicable for the tonnage held (II/3= less than 500 GT. II/2- 500 GT/3000 GT, or II/2- greater than 3000 GT).

If mariner holds National deck officer endorsement with corresponding STCW not limited to UFIV and the tonnage is higher than the tonnage limitation of the UFIV, issue the STCW Deck Officer Capacity without the UFIV limitation on the STCW and the with the applicable STCW limitations (example; Not valid or Near Coastal, Limited to 3,000 GT or less, Not valid on ARPA, etc.)

Original applications for UFIV requested to be endorsed on a STCW will **not** be issued.
