<b>MASTER UFIV</b>	<b>46 CFR</b>	
1440 days of total service on Ocean, Near Coastal or Great Lakes waters, <b>OF WHICH:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Service on Inland waters, other than Great Lakes, MAY substitute for up to 720 days of the required service, <b>AND</b></li> <li>2. 360 days of service <b>MUST</b> have been as master, mate, or equivalent position while holding an endorsement as master, mate, OUPV, or master or mate (pilot) of towing vessels.</li> </ol>	11.462	
<b>Tonnage Calculations</b>	<b>46 CFR</b>	
<b>Less Than 500 GRT</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. 720 days of the above required 1440 days service must have been on vessels of 50 GRT or more, <b>AND</b></li> <li>2. The 360 days of service as Master, Mate or equivalent required above must be on vessels of 50 GRT or more.</li> </ol>	11.462	
<b>Less Than 1600 GRT</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. 720 days of the above required 1440 days service must have been on vessels of 100 GRT or more, <b>AND</b></li> <li>2. The 360 days of service as Master, Mate or equivalent required above must be on vessels of 100 GRT or more.</li> </ol>	11.462	
<b>Greater than 1600 GRT but not to exceed 5000 GRT</b> - Vessel Tonnage is based upon the 1440 days of total service was obtained will be used to compute the tonnage. The Tonnage Calculation MMS may be completed but not required <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Tonnage will be limited to max tonnage on which 25% of the experience is obtained, <b>OR</b></li> <li>2. Tonnage will be limited to 150% tonnage of which 50% of service obtained, <b>whichever greater.</b> (See limitation note next page)</li> </ol>	11.462	
<b>Note:</b> Limitations are in multiples of 1000 GRT (minimum issuance is 2000 GRT), using next higher figure when an intermediate tonnage is calculated, but cannot exceed 5000 GRT	11.462	

<b>To Remove Tonnage Limitations (Not to exceed 5000 GRT):</b>	<b>46 CFR</b>	
90 days service as Master on a vessel results in a limitation in that capacity equal to the tonnage of the vessel served rounded up to the next multiple of 1000 GRT; <b>OR</b>	11.462	
180 days service as Master on a vessel results in a limitation in that capacity equal to 150% tonnage of vessel served as master ; <b>OR</b>	11.462	
180 days service as Master on vessels over 1600 GRT results in raising the limitation to 5000 GRT; <b>OR</b>	11.462	
180 days service as Mate on vessels over 1600GRT results in raising the limitation for Master to the tonnage on which at least 50% of the service as Mate was obtained; <b>OR</b>	11.462	
720 days service as deckhand on a vessel while holding a MMC as Master results in a limitation equal to 150% of the tonnage of that vessel service as deckhand was obtained up to 5000GRT; <b>OR</b>	11.462	
360 days service as deckhand on a vessel while holding a MMC as Master results in a limitation equal to the tonnage of the vessel served.	11.462

**Renewal Notes:**

Mariners currently holding STCW officer endorsement limited to UFIV and only a national officer endorsement for UFIV may continue to renew as long as Basic Training renewal requirements have been met. The UFIV will continue to be endorsed as a limitation to the Master and the Basic Training will be listed as a separate capacity.

In order to remove the UFIV limitation, mariner must meet full STCW requirements as applicable for the tonnage held (II/3= less than 500 GT. II/2- 500 GT/3000 GT, or II/2- greater than 3000 GT).

If mariner holds National deck officer endorsement with corresponding STCW not limited to UFIV and the tonnage is higher than the tonnage limitation of the UFIV, issue the STCW Deck Officer Capacity without the UFIV limitation on the STCW and the with the applicable STCW limitations (example; Not valid or Near Coastal, Limited to 3,000 GT or less, Not valid on ARPA, etc.)

**Original** applications for UFIV requested to be endorsed on a STCW **will not** be issued.
