Professional Nurse – Valid license as a registered nurse issued under authority of a state or territory of the US, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, or the District of Columbia.	11.807	
Marine Physician Assistant – Successful completion of an accredited course of instruction for a physician's assistant or nurse practitioner program.	11.807	
Hospital Corpsman – Rating of at least hospital corpsman or health services technician, 1st class in the US Navy, US Coast Guard, US Marine Corps, or an equivalent rating in the US Army (not less than staff sergeant, Medical Department, USA.), or in the US Air Force (not less than technical sergeant, Medical Department, USAF), and a period of satisfactory service of at least 1 month in a military hospital or US Public Health Service Hospital.	11.807
