Examinations Working Group – Résumé Details

Résumés should include (but are not limited to) applicable information as follows:

- Name, address, phone number, and e-mail address
- Mariner reference number or MMC document number
- U.S. Deck or Engineering MMC endorsements held
- Seagoing experience, including:
 - Capacity served
 - Vessel type
 - Tonnage
 - Routes
 - Cargo experience
 - o Modes of propulsion
 - Horsepower
- Areas of maritime-specific subject matter expertise including training and experience.
 As the review process continues, the Coast Guard will need working group members with extensive experience in specific industry segments such as towing on various routes, gas propulsion modes, etc. Greater detail provided by applicants on résumés will allow a more appropriate distribution of questions within specific topic areas.
- Association with State Maritime Academies or approved training organizations including subject matter instructed and experience in training/assessment development
- Current membership in a maritime-related advisory committee(s) such as:
 - Merchant Marine Personnel Advisory Council (MERPAC)
 - Towing Safety Advisory Committee (TSAC)
 - o Merchant Mariner Medical Advisory Committee (MEDMAC)
 - National Offshore Safety Advisory Committee (NOSAC)
- Human performance technology expertise.

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
