RE: Interstate Bridge Replacement Program Coast Guard Bridge Permitting Process

Dear Sir,

Greenberry Industrial, LLC (Greenberry), is an Oregon limited liability company that specializes in the construction and fabrication of deepwater, large scale, modular projects for a number of industries including in the energy sectors, at a site it leases in the Columbia Business Center ("CBC) located adjacent to the Columbia River in Vancouver, Washington, upstream from the Interstate Bridge Replacement Program's (IBR) proposed I-5 Columbia River bridge, designed with a fixed span at 116' of vertical clearance from zero Columbia River Datum (Proposed Bridge Design). Greenberry depends, in significant part, upon shipping its products by way of the navigable waters of the Columbia River.
