The Commander, Thirteenth Coast Guard District has received an application from BNSF Railway Co. (BNSF), requesting approval of location and plans for a new bridge over a navigable waterway of the United States. At this time the Coast Guard has not completed the draft environmental document and a separate public notice (PN) and Federal Register notice will be published announcing the document and its availability at a future date. Therefore, this PN is soliciting for comments exclusively related to navigation. The public is highly encouraged to carefully review this notice, attached plans, and diagrams and then provide comments with regard to the proposed bridge's ability to meet the reasonable needs of navigation.

<u>WATERWAY AND LOCATION</u>: Sand Creek, river mile 0.1, in Bonner County, ID, at latitude, longitude 48°16′19.35"N, 116°32′38.17"W.

<u>CHARACTER OF WORK</u>: BNSF proposes to construct a new bridge approximately 23.4 feet west of, and parallel to, the existing bridge, and will be 505 feet long (approximately 150 feet over navigable areas of Sand Creek) and 21 feet wide. The existing bridge will remain in service.








Current navigation and bridge pier configuration


BNSF Bridge 3.1 over Sand Creek Current and proposed bridge pier placement


