## BRIDGE PERMIT (130-68)

18 JUL 1968

WHEREAS by Title V of an act of Congress approved August 2, 1946, entitled General Bridge Act of 1946, as amended, (33 U.S.C. 525-533) the consent of Congress was granted for the construction, maintenance, and operation of bridges and approaches thereto over the navigable waters of the United States;

AND WHEREAS under Section 502(b) of said act as transferred to and vested in the Secretary of Transportation by Section 6(g)(6)(C) of the Department of Transportation Act (80 Stat. 931) and delegated by the Secretary to the Commandant, U. S. Coast Guard in Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 1, it is required that the location and plans for such bridges be approved by the Commandant before construction is commenced and in approving the location and plans of any such bridge, the Commandant may impose any specific conditions relating to the maintenance and operation of the structure which he deems necessary in the interest of public navigation, such conditions to have the force of law;

AND WHEREAS the - GREAT NORTHERN RAILWAY COMPANY - has submitted plans and a map of location of a bridge to be constructed across SAND CREEK at Sandpoint, Idaho;

NOW THEREFORE, This is to certify that the location and plans dated 27 May 1968 are hereby approved by the Commandant, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. No deviation from the approved plans shall be made either before or after completion of the structure unless the modification of said plans has previously been submitted to and received the approval of the Commandant.
- 2. All work shall be so conducted that the free navigation of the waterway is not unreasonably interfered with and the present navigable depths are not impaired. The construction of cofferdams, falsework, pilings or other obstructions, if required, shall be accomplished in accordance with plans submitted to and approved by the Commander, Thirteenth Coast Guard District prior to construction of the bridge. The channel or channels through the structure shall be promptly cleared of all obstructions placed therein or caused by the construction of the bridge to the satisfaction of the District Commander, when in his judgment the construction work has reached a point where such action should be taken, and in any case not later than ninety days after the bridge has been opened to traffic.
- 3. Issuance of this permit does not relieve the permittee of the obligation or responsibility for compliance with the provisions of any other law or regulation under the jurisdiction of any other federal, state or local authority having cognizance of any aspect of the construction, operation and maintenance of said bridge.

BRIDGE PERMIT: Great Northern Railway Company bridge to be constructed (130-68) across Sand Creek at Sandpoint, Idaho

- 4. All parts of the existing railroad bridge at mile 1.12 shall be removed down to the natural bottom of the waterway and the channel cleared to the satisfaction of the Commander, Thirteenth Coast Guard District not later than ninety days after completion of the new railroad bridge at mile 1.35 or when said bridge has been opened to rail traffic, whichever occurs first.
- 5. The approval hereby granted shall cease and be null and void unless the actual construction of the bridge be commenced within 2 years and completed within 4 years of the date of this permit.




